**Education:**

Sir Andrew Green graduated from Cambridge in 1962 with a degree in Natural Sciences, Economics and Politics.

**Professional Experience:**

After a Short Service Commission in the British Army (spent in Borneo and Berlin) he joined the Diplomatic Service in 1965.

After studying Arabic in Shemlan in 1966/1967 he spent 16 years altogether in the Arab world, serving in 5 posts: Aden, Abu Dhabi, Syria and Saudi Arabia (twice). The rest of his service was in London, Paris or Washington.

He was Ambassador to Syria (1991-1994), Director for the Middle East in the FCO (1994-1996) and Ambassador to Saudi Arabia (1996-2000).

On retirement he became Chairman of Medical Aid for Palestinians from 2001-2004 and a board member of Christian Solidarity Worldwide. He also founded and now chairs a think-tank on migration issues.

He was elected Co-Chairman of the British Syrian Society in 2005.
